RESET SAFARI

STEP 1.

- Click **Go** → select **Go to folder** → Type: ~/Library → **Hit Go**
- Move to Trash → **cookies, cache and safari**

STEP 2.

- Navigate to Folder → **Saved Application State**
- Move to Trash → **com.apple.Safari.savedState**

Close the window.

STEP 3.

Now open **Terminal**

- Copy and Paste these all commands at once in Terminal.

rm -Rf ~/Library/Caches/Apple\ -\ Safari\ -\ Safari\ Extensions\ Gallery; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Caches/Metadata/Safari; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Caches/com.apple.Safari; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Caches/com.apple.WebKit.PluginProcess; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Cookies/Cookies.binarycookies; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/Apple\ -\ Safari\ -\ Safari\ Extensions\ Gallery; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.Safari.LSSharedFileList.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.Safari.RSS.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.Safari.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.WebFoundation.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.WebKit.PluginHost.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Preferences/com.apple.WebKit.PluginProcess.plist; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/PubSub/Database; \  
rm -Rf ~/Library/Saved\ Application\ State/com.apple.Safari.savedState
```

These commands will fully wipe out all of your old Safari settings
